vim shortcuts

vim modes

- normal mode - "ESC"
- insert mode - "i"
- command mode - ":"

Normal mode

h - move left

j - move down

k - move up

l - move right

w - jump to next word

W - jump to next string

b - jump to previous word

B - jump to previous string

0 - move to first position in line

\$ - move to end of the line

z + enter - move to the top

2gg or **2G** - move to line 2

ctrl g show how many lines in file

delete

x - delete char where cursor is

X - delete char before cursor

dw - **d** - delete **w** - motion

dl - delete word on left

dk - delete up line

dh - delete down line

dj - delete word on right

d0 - delete all to begin line

dd or **D**- delete all line

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
